SUNY - New Paltz University – Master Energy Plan – Insulation Upgrades

Project Overview:

Brian Pine, Energy Management Coordinator for SUNY New Paltz, was awarded a grant from NYPA (New York Power Authority) through the OMAP for pipe insulation, in December of 2015. The Operations & Maintenance Acceleration Program (OMAP) is a suite of offerings aimed at helping State agencies go beyond capital projects and improve their facilities. ThermaXX conducted a campus wide insulation energy assessment detailing the projected thermal savings in 27 buildings.

Specification Highlights: The 660 insulation jackets installed by East Coast Hazmat were manufactured by ThermaXX in West Haven, CT. All materials are USA made. The jackets were designed to an outside touch temp of under 120 degrees F. The closures on the jackets make for quick removal and replacement. The jackets were outfitted with QR coded tags (SLATES) that assist with asset management and mechanical record keeping. Energy savings and ambient temperature reduction are still the highlights of this project!

Savings Information: ThermaXX’s survey documented the savings based on the hours of operation, operating temperature, size of piping and components and the mmbtu cost. This project rendered over 50,000 therms saved and a five-year savings of over \$250,000.
